OUR VALUES AND HOUSE RULES

We welcome you to the Three Strands guesthouse and we hope that your time in Haiti is profitable. We have a few house rules that we believe will enhance your stay.

As a Christian non-profit organization, we ask that you show respect both to the local culture and to our values. We are a health ministry, and we ask that you set a good example by refraining from smoking and alcohol use while on the compound. Please respect the privacy of the separate dorm areas and bathrooms for each sex.

Three Strands employs security personnel and the guesthouse is located inside a walled compound that is gated at night. However, just like a hotel, it is in your best interest to secure your valuables on your person. Be sure to keep your passport with you at all times. Lock windows and doors at night and when you leave.

Our Haitien workers are paid employees as well as family members. Thanks in advance for displaying the utmost respect for our staff.



SERVICES PROVIDED

- Men and women's dormitory style rooms with single beds and private bathrooms
- 10 beds in each room and 4 private bathrooms with showers.
- Sheets and pillows
- Generator on from sunset to sunrise to provide electricity for lighting, ceiling fans, and air conditioning
- Wireless internet access
- Local chefs make up to three meals/day of delicious Caribbean cuisine in the guest dining room
- Bottled water and soft drinks (if requested)
- Reliable transportation

- Towels
- Toiletries

RATES

Transportation rates per car per day:
